Day 1:

SSC NASSCOM in association with Paschim Bangla Society for Skill Development, Department of Technical Education, Training and Skill Development, Govt of West Bengal conducted Job Fair at Calcutta Technical school (CTS) S.N. Banerjee Road, Kolkata on 19th & 20th September 2019.

Job Mela was inaugurated by Smt. Roshni Sen (Principal Secretary – DTET & SD) and Shri Subrata Banerjee –Chairperson- WBSCTVESD .

As Chief Guest, Smt. Roshni, addressed the participants on the importance of bridging the gap between right Skills and relevant Jobs, and the efforts taken by Govt of West Bengal with SSC NASSCOM towards it. The Mega placement drive had about 1500 Plus students participating from Polytechnic, ITI's, Utkarsh Bangla VET schools and students from various Academic & Professional Institutions event was a mirror of healthy interaction between the Job Seekers, Industry representatives.

Students trained in various IT-ITeS Skills from various colleges & Institutions across West Bengal attended the event and were highly appreciative of the efforts in bringing together 20 companies to participate with about 3000 plus Job openings. Top IT & BPO companies like Wipro, TCS, Genpact, Globsyn 3rd Eye, Fusion BPO, Startek, Mjunction, Genius Consulting, and Met Technologies have participating in this job fair.

We observed a footfall of 768 candidates from all segments and sectors with shortlisting of 134 candidates from corporates who as well represented themselves in day 1 of the event. As we move towards the successful closure of this mega event, the happy corporates assured us of their willingness to participate in more such job fairs in future. The exemplary support from the Government of West Bengal would further instigate and encourage NASSCOM to come forward and repeat this kind of job fair in near future to bring industry and skilled candidates in a single platform to mitigate the skill gap and create more talent pool for the industry.
